By the way, rain is no obstacle for all yogis, because then the healthy hour takes place in the Museum Kitzbühel.

PURA VIDA Kitzbühel addresses itself however just as to the small guests. Starting at 4.00 p.m., they can transform themselves into animal friends or superheroes at the children's face painting event organized by the Lisi Family Hotel in the courtyard of St. Catherine's Church. Among the favorites of the little ones are also the nimble fingers of the balloon animal artists and the original clowns with their entertaining program.
